E-journal/journal access and use

Under copyright guidelines you must:

- Follow the terms and conditions detailed below and provided on the linked sites. Terms, conditions and copyright restrictions are usually listed on the homepage of the individual publisher or service.
- Ensure RCOT membership numbers and passwords are not known or passed to any other individuals.
- Include an acknowledgement and reference all uses of an article appropriately. If you are having difficulty referencing, please speak with your university/hospital librarian or the RCOT Library and Information Service via <u>library@rcot.co.uk</u>.

You can:

- Access, search and browse abstracts and the full-text of electronic articles.
- Print and/or download a single article/abstract from any **single** journal issue for private study or research for a non-commercial purpose.

You cannot

- Print and/or download more than one journal article in any one journal issue.
- Download abstracts or full-text articles systematically, automatically or in bulk.
- Use journal content for commercial purposes.

Please acknowledge and reference all copies, unless it is impractical to do so. Breaching a license goes against Library regulations and may lead to the publisher withdrawing their service from RCOT.
