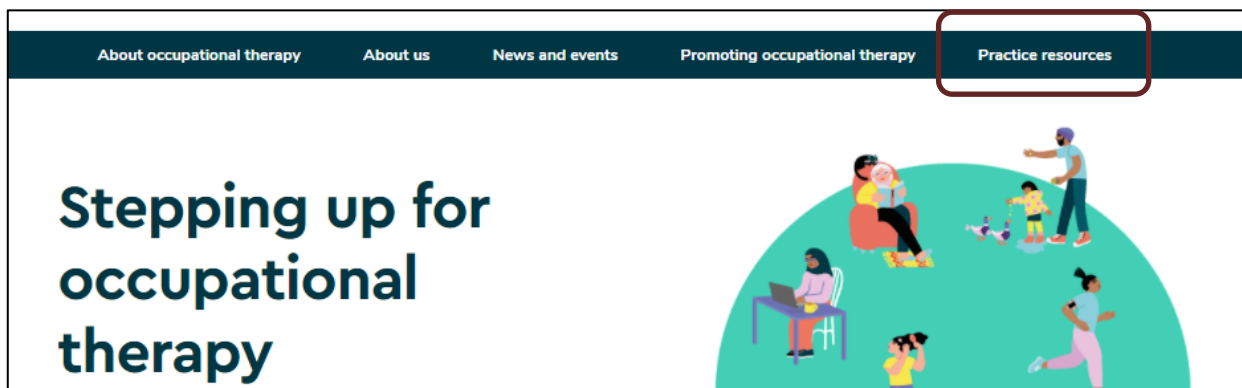

- a) **Access the Library catalogue** to read Ebooks and Etheses / online PhD dissertations on occupational therapy, related topics and research
- b) **Access the CINAHL and Medline databases** to search for, and access, full text journal articles on subjects of your choice
- c) **Ebooks** browse and read ebooks direct from our supplier platforms
- d) **Information skills guides** help you use our resources and services, e.g. carry out a literature search, use databases, navigate the Library catalogue
- e) **Ejournals** browse our ejournals by *title* A-Z and link through to full text articles. Open Access titles are included. (To *search* for journal articles, see point b) above)

The Library provides access to full-text electronic journals relevant to occupational therapy which can support and inform your practice and clinical and management decision-making.

Before accessing the e-journals, please ensure your pop-up blocker is disabled. If you experience difficulties it may also help to try accessing the e-journals at home.
